- park close to others as feasible as possible, try not to leave too much space in between cars
- car pool when you have a group going out on your boat, if that's not possible block each other in to leave space for other members.
- Remember in case of an emergency an ambulance will need to get thru

Please remember that this is OUR CLUB and we need to maintain it. If trash cans need to be empty, take to the dumpster, if the decks need to be cleaned up, clean them, pick up all trash. If you see something that needs to be repaired, bring it to the Officers attention. Modifications to the club and/or pier are not permitted without the Board's approval.
